Few executives have shaped the Gulf South's workers' compensation market like David Bondy. In 1991, he founded LUBA Workers' Comp to give employers a more responsive alternative in a market long dominated by national carriers. Today, the Baton Rouge-based insurer serves thousands of businesses across Louisiana and neighboring states. Bondy's influence extends beyond the company he built. Earlier in his career, he helped champion legislation enabling Louisiana's first workers' compensation group self-insurance funds—expanding risk-management options for employers.
